The Old Town Association is a 501(c)(3) Organization pleased to announce a \$500 scholarship to be awarded to a University, college or technical school bound student who has a passion for his or her intended career choice.

Eligibility

To be eligible for The Old Town Association scholarship, the student must meet the following requirements:

- 1) Own/family a building in Old Town Cottonwood
- 2) Own/family a business in Old Town Cottonwood
- 3) Be employed at a business in Old Town Cottonwood
- 4) Be a resident in Old Town
- 5) Old Town Cottonwood boundary is from Cactus St. to 7th street

Scholarship Selection

The Scholarship Selection Committee is made up of individuals on the board of The Old Town Association board of Directors. The committee will review the applications and select the award recipient on an impartial basis. An in-person or telephone interview may be part of the selection process. If there is no suitable candidate for the scholarship as deemed by the committee, a scholarship will not be given for that year.

Scholarship Notification

The scholarship recipient will be notified by email and/or phone within 24 hours of the selection committee's decision. In addition, the scholarship winner's name and photo will be posted on the The Old Town Associations website and Facebook page.

Scholarship Amount and Payment

The amount of the scholarship is, \$500.00 and, payment will be made directly to the recipient's school account.
